Assignment

Staple 5-10 pieces of notebook paper together to create a “journal”. Create a cover page that contains the title and your name. Feel free to decorate the cover if you'd like. Attach more pages if necessary. After every four chapters, complete a journal entry.

Each entry should contain the following:

Title of entry (example: Chapters 1-4)

Characters (new characters/brief description/role in the story)

New or unfamiliar vocabulary words (write them down and look up definition)

A brief summary of what happened (important events/plot changes)

Your reflection (feelings, reactions, questions, predictions, quotes, etc.)
